

# AirPurify 2026 Buying Guide

Choose the right purifier size, filter type, and running cost before you buy.

## Match the purifier to the room

- Measure room area and ceiling height
- Prefer CADR data over marketing room size
- Target at least four air changes per hour
- Separate bedroom and open-plan needs
- Avoid undersized desktop units for large rooms

## Filter and noise checks

- Use true HEPA for fine particles
- Use carbon only when odor or VOCs matter
- Compare replacement filter price
- Check noise at sleep speed
- Avoid ionizer-first products when possible

## Operating cost

- Estimate yearly filter spend
- Check wattage at normal speed
- Confirm filter availability in your country
- Review warranty exclusions
- Plan placement with 30 cm airflow clearance

# Decision checklist

Score each line before buying. If two or more boxes stay unchecked, keep comparing products.

Check	Done	Notes
CADR fits the room		
Filter cost is acceptable		
Sleep mode is quiet enough		
Replacement filters are available		
No unwanted ozone/ionizer dependency
